**JOB DESCRIPTION:** Reporting to the Director of Engineering Services and Exterior Services, is responsible for managing the building commissioning processes for the Facilities Management Department. Serves as the liaison for the University Facilities Project Management Team and the third party Commissioning Agent. Provides technical assistance for Facilities Management project management staff and Plant Operations and Maintenance shops, including HVAC and Controls shops. Works closely with Project Managers to ensure the university project close-out process is completed and that construction drawing documents and O & M manuals are received, distributed and properly archived. Participates on all LEED certification teams for university capital projects. Performs related responsibilities as required.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:** A bachelor's degree in Mechanical or Electrical Engineering and three years of experience with Commissioning or related processes or an equivalent combination of education, training and experience.
