

CEFP and EFP Credentialing Program Reimbursement Procedures

To stimulate further development in the field of facilities management and to advance the purposes of the Association, GAPP is committed to providing assistance to qualified applicants of member institutions.

Through APPA, qualified applicants may complete online course work to help prepare for either the Certified Educational Facilities Professional (CEFP) or Educational Facilities Professional (EFP) Credentialing Program.

Coupons are available through SRAPPA and must be applied prior to application of GAPP reimbursement.

GAPP will reimburse the applicant for the cost of their coursework, less any coupon or other scholarship that was applied, upon the successful completion of exam.

To ensure that the GAPP Board is knowledgeable of all upcoming financial obligations, prior to their registration and participation in the Program, qualified applicants must notify the Scholarship Committee Chair with their intentions of beginning their coursework via email. Upon completion, applicant must submit a copy of their paid invoice for the coursework and proof of their exam passing. The Request for Reimbursement form should be used for the expense reimbursement request.
